Requirements

- 🕒 Transfer per PDF file format
- 🕒 Proof approved by the buyer as binding test specimen
- 🕒 No corrections shall be mentioned in the approved PDF file nor in the proof returned by the buyer
- 🕒 The name of the PDF file shall mention the reference of the substrate and/or article
- 🕒 Integrated punching outline Offsetdruckerei Schwarzach
- 🕒 Punching outlines and surfaces to be coated must be displayed in a separate colour that is not otherwise used in the design of the document.
- 🕒 Braille characters, security features, security texts etc. including the punching outline must be displayed in legible form as additional page or file in PDF format or in the proof returned by the purchaser.
- 🕒 The background of the PDF file must be in white
- 🕒 The PDF file shall not be scaled

When securing the PDF file, please take care of the following

- 🕒 correctly embedded fonts, if possible vectorize texts
- 🕒 CMYK mode (avoid RGB mode)
- 🕒 no embedded LOW-RES or JPEG images
- 🕒 observe overprint options
- 🕒 if special colours are used in images (DCS with open files), transparency and overprint, please send preprepared PDF files. Thus eventual error sources due to differences of interpretation and of systems will be avoided.
